Thevisitor Discussion Guide Active Voice

When should active voice be used? Sentences containing active voice can be easier to process and understand than passive voice sentences. This is because they provide more information (the agent of the action), and possibly because native English speakers are accustomed to receiving the information in the order agent-action-receiver. Active voice sentences may be more concise than passive voice sentences because they eliminate the need for a helping verb “be” and the preposition “by.”

1) It’s less direct than active voice. Active: The lumberjack demolished the tree. Passive: The tree was demolished by the lumberjack. The active sentence packs more of a punch, and it immediately establishes who’s doing what. 2) Active voice can convey the same message in fewer words. Active: Both leaders will sign the treaty. (6 words)

Active vs. passive voice. In a sentence written in the active voice, the subject of sentence performs the action. In a sentence written in the passive voice the subject receives the action. Active: The candidate believes that Congress must place a ceiling on the budget.

Active and Passive Voice Voice refers to the form of a verb that indicates when a grammatical subject performs the action or is the receiver of the action. When a sentence is written in the active voice, the subject performs the action; in the passive voice, the subject receives the action.

The active voice refers to a sentence format that emphasizes the doer of an action. For example, in the sentence “The mice inhaled the tobacco-infused aerosol,” the doer, i.e., “the mice” seem important. On the other hand, in the passive voice, the action being performed is emphasized, and the doer may be omitted, e.g.,

Active Voice:: I know him. Passive Voice: He is known to me. Active Voice: Water fills a tub. Passive Voice: A tub is filled with water. Rule No. 5. The auxiliary verb will be changed in Passive Voice depending upon the tense of sentence in its Active Voice.

Active and Passive Voice - Basic Rules with Examples

Reviewing examples of active and passive voice will make it easier to understand the difference. Active voice describes a sentence where the subject performs the action stated by the verb. In passive sentences, the subject is acted upon by the verb.

Examples of Active and Passive Voice

Active voice refers to sentences in which the subject comes before the verb and the object, such as: Joe threw the ball. It is the opposite of passive voice , in which the object comes first:

Using active voice often improves clarity, while passive voice can help avoid unnecessary repetition. Active voice can help ensure clarity by making it clear to the reader who is taking action in the sentence. In addition, the active voice stresses that the actor (or grammatical subject) precedes the verb, again, putting emphasis on the subject.

Active voice is used for most non-scientific writing. Using active voice for the majority of your sentences makes your meaning clear for readers, and keeps the sentences from becoming too complicated or wordy. Even in scientific writing, too much use of passive voice can cloud the meaning of your sentences.

In the simplest terms, an active voice sentence is written in the form of “A does B.” (For example, “Carmen sings the song.”) A passive voice sentence is written in the form of “B is done by A.” (For

example, “The song is sung by Carmen.”)

Sentences written in the active voice are easier to understand than sentences written in the passive voice. Switching the passive voice into the active voice is straightforward, but it requires a bit of practice. In the equivalency table below, notice that the tense of the verb to be in the passive voice is always the same as the tense of the main verb in the active voice.

A sentence is considered to be in passive voice when the subject of a sentence is the object being acted on. Active voice, on the other hand, is where the subject is the one doing the acting.

How to Effectively Use Active and Passive Voice in ...

Active voice is a quality of a verb that describes when its subject is acting out the verb. When the opposite is true (i.e., the subject of the sentence is being acted upon by the verb), it is said to be in passive voice.
